Washington, D.C.- The National Committee for Responsive Philanthropy (NCRP) announces the selection of Aaron Dorfman as its new Executive Director. Dorfman is currently the executive director and lead organizer of People Acting for Community Together (PACT).

In 1992, Dorfman began his notable career in grassroots advocacy with the Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now (ACORN). Under his leadership, ACORN grew from a small organization to a national network of over 100 local chapters.

Under Dorfman’s leadership, PACT quadrupled its member institutions, raised their annual budget more than fivefold, and became a leading voice in the fight for social justice.

Dorfman expressed his pleasure at being chosen to lead the premier philanthropic watchdog organization. “I am honored to join NCRP and to continue the work of advocating for the poor and vulnerable,” he said.
