WASHINGTON-The National Committee for Responsive Philanthropy (NCRP) today released a new report, *Social Justice Philanthropy: The Latest Trend or a Lasting Lens for Grantmaking?*. The report's findings indicate that social justice philanthropy is fraught with many definitional variations, making it difficult to measure and compare. Based upon two years of data collection and analysis, NCRP developed a definition of social justice philanthropy and identified key trends in the field. The report also features research findings drawn from data on several hundred foundations identified as social justice philanthropies.
