ility Fall Seriously Short of Addressing the Critical Issues Undermining Nonprofit Accountability and Tru

The nation's only philanthropic watchdog, the National Committee for Responsive Philanthropy (NCRP) has issued a comprehensive statement on the Independent Sector's recommendations on nonprofit accountability. "Despite having raised more than \$3 million to support their work, a panel of nonprofit leaders has generated recommendations that are fundamentally flawed and inadequate to address the critical issues undermining nonprofit accountability," the statement reads. The attached statement outlines multiple inadequacies in the recommendations that the Senate Finance Committee's subcommittee on Nonprofit Organizations and Philanthropy issued last week. The National Committee for Responsive Philanthropy issued a comprehensive set of foundation accountability recommendations last month. "It's all too clear that the real agenda behind the policy recommendations to be presented to the Senate Finance Committee is to undermine the ability of the independent sector to hold foundations accountable for their actions," the statement reads. "The NCRP statement demonstrates the utter inadequacy of the self-regulation agenda that is being pitched by the independent sector."
