NCRP Joins ACLU Coalition in Condemning

Should Not Be Relegated to the Nonprofit Sector, Says Philanthropic Watchdog

WASHINGTON-The National Committee for Responsive Philanthropy (NCRP), as part of an ACLU-led coalition, today condemned the federal government's new policy on the treatment of charities. "While the government has a right and obligation to protect citizens from terrorism, the CFC situation is a clear violation of the First Amendment," said Naomi Tacuyan, NCRP's executive director. "The most likely result of the CFC policy will not be that terrorism is curbed, but that CFC charities will be forced to operate in a hostile environment. NCRP looks forward to working with members of the ACLU-led coalition and others to oppose the CFC policy."
